

Farmacia Etc's PRESCRIPTION PROGRAM DETAILS

1. Some Prescription Discount Cards may be used at Farmacia Etc. These Cards may be used in conjunction with other insurance plans - including Medicare and Medicaid. The Discount Card may assist patients with a coverage gap or “donut hole”. **However**, this card may not be used towards the \$2 to \$10 Prescription Program for generic medications already being discounted.
2. The Program applies only to certain generic drugs at commonly prescribed dosages. Higher dosages cost more. Not all formulations of a drug (for example, enteric-coated, extended or timed release formulations) are covered under the Program. Program pricing is not available when a covered drug is dispensed as part of a compound.
3. Under our Program, \$2 to \$4 is the price for up to a 30-day supply of certain covered generic drugs at commonly prescribed dosages. \$10 is the price of a 90-day supply of certain covered generic drugs at commonly prescribed dosages. Not all drugs covered by the \$4 Program are covered by the \$10 Program. Prices for quantities between a 30-day supply and a 90-day supply of drugs covered are prorated based on the \$4 Program price, but will not exceed \$10 prices for quantities greater than a 90-day supply of drugs covered by the \$10 Program.
4. Under the Program through Farmacia Etc, \$10 is the price for mail delivery of a 90-day supply of certain generics. Not all drugs covered by the \$10 Retail Program are covered by the \$10 Mail Service Program. Farmacia Etc's Mail Service covers both initial fills and refills. Delivery under the Program of Mail Service is limited to Texas, California, Massachusetts, Pennsylvania, Washington and West Virginia. Expedited delivery is available for an additional charge.
5. Prepackaged drugs are covered under the Program only in the unit sizes specified . Prepackaged drugs are dispensed based on the quantities prescribed and unit sizes in stock at the dispensing pharmacy. Multi-unit purchases are charged at a per unit price, based on the price per unit size dispensed, unless otherwise specified. Prorated pricing is not available under the Program for prepackaged drugs.
6. Program pricing may be limited to select manufacturers of a covered drug and is available as long as supplies from such manufacturers are in stock at the dispensing pharmacy.
7. You may pay less or more than the Program price, depending on the terms of your health plan. Prescriber permission may be required to change a 30-day prescription to a 90-day prescription. Certain plans, including government-funded programs, may not cover a 90-day supply.
8. For purchases made at Farmacia Etc, prescriptions must initially be filled in person.
